The Faculty of Medicine at the University of Tübingen invites applications for a position at the Institute for Medical Virology and Epidemiology of Viral Diseases at the Department of Diagnostic Lab Medicine of the University Hospital Tübingen as a

Professorship (W2) of Immunology of Viral Infections (f/m/d)

to be filled as soon as possible.

The position is made available for a period of six years according to § 50 (2) (5) of the Baden-Württemberg state law covering higher education and specifically the promotion of highly gifted junior researchers.

The call is addressed to scientists and physicians.

The successful candidate should be internationally recognized in the field of immunology of viral infections. The research focus may include functional aspects of immune system - virus interactions, immune evasion, and immune defense of viral infections as well as immunology of viral tumor diseases and chronic infections by relevant human pathogenic viruses. Research topics may comprise both innate as well as adaptive immune responses. Participation in the research areas infection biology and immune therapy as well as the participation in current and planned DFG-funded research networks and the existing German Centres for Health Research (German Center for Infection Research (DZIF) and German Cancer Consortium (DKTK)) is expected. Teaching at the Faculty of Medicine in the degree programs Human Medicine, Molecular Medicine, Medical Technology, Nursing Science, and Midwifery Science is mandatory.

Required qualifications include a PhD/MD or equivalent international degrees and postdoctoral qualifications equivalent to the requirements for tenure. This includes evidence of teaching effectiveness.

The University of Tübingen is particularly interested in increasing the share of women in research and teaching and therefore strongly encourages women candidates to apply. In line with its internationalization agenda, the university welcomes applications from researchers outside Germany.

Applications from equally qualified candidates with disabilities will be given preference.
