- Evaluation of feasibility, acceptance and usability of the consultation

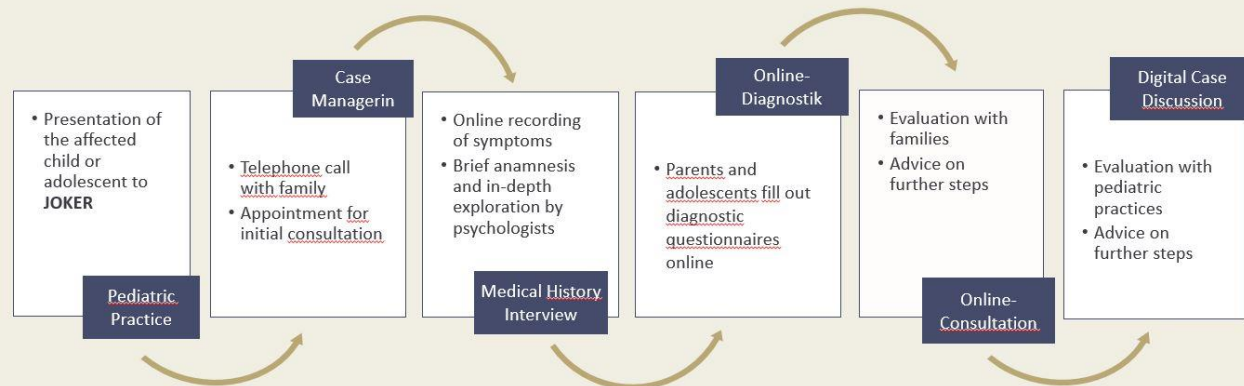
